Building a Multimedia Future

Executive Director's Report

So much information is available 24-7. So much of it is noise. Most of it comes from the commercial media of the largest cities and from some of the largest corporations in the world. Salem is not on their radar screen.

For 28 years, we've worked to make CCTV a reliable source for community-based information. Building on our history and support from the City of Salem and Marion County, CCTV continues to help local governments, schools, non-profit organizations and individuals connect with this community. We know that we can reach people. Although we have no cable TV viewer statistics, more than 48,000 joined us on YouTube for solar eclipse coverage, with another 10,000 watching on Facebook.

The City of Salem and Marion County did a great job of negotiating with Comcast to provide valuable resources for the future. Here's a look at a key new role for CCTV and a peak at what's ahead as we look for further development and reach.

Multimedia Wing, Joint Information Center (JIC)

CCTV is working with the City of Salem and Marion County to add a multimedia wing in the vacant space adjacent to and east of CCTV. The wing is designed to serve emergency communicators as a Joint Information Center (JIC) and will be a great outlet for community groups. Imagine the ability to reach an audience via television, the internet and radio at the same time. Stay tuned for details.

Ashley Gruber, Full-time Media Instructor, and Center 50+

Half-time was not enough for all that Ashley has brought to CCTV. She starts full time in July. Our community will see that the Newbery Challenge video festival for youth was the tip of the iceberg on cool, new classes and fun-filled learning. Ashley will be expanding classes to Center 50+ by popular demand.

A brand new, shiny HD channel

In 2018 CCTV expects to launch its first HD channel. Expect a substantial campaign as we deliver to you the same terrific signal we see in our production monitors. We can't wait!

A well-informed, actively-involved citizenry makes more responsible decisions. CCTV televises local government meetings, activities of local schools, and service-related information to stimulate an active dialogue among elected officials, schools, and local citizens.

COMMUNITY DECISION-MAKING

Freedom of expression alone is not enough to ensure a healthy democracy. Citizens must also enter into active discussion and debate in order to participate in solving problems for the common good. CCTV promotes the use of non-commercial channels 21, 22, 23 and production facilities as an electronic forum for discussing issues and solving problems.

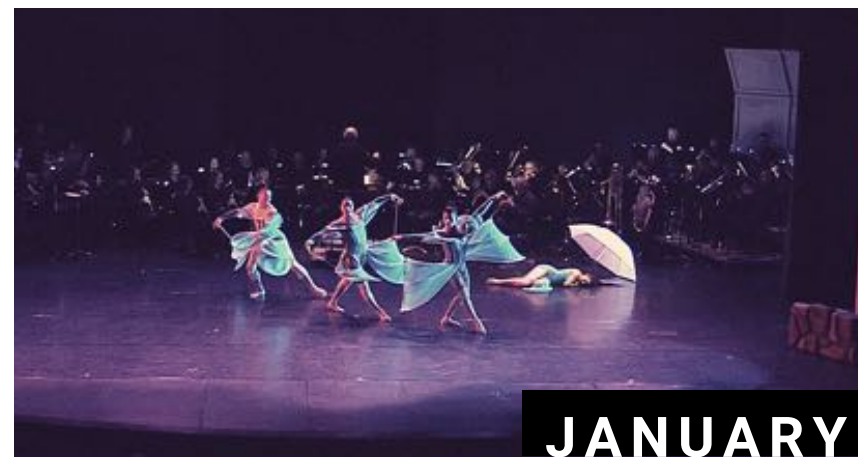

HIGHLIGHTS



JULY 2017

CCTV kicked off July with three weeks of Summer Video Camp, which concluded with a film premiere for family and friends-- what a creative bunch! Later in the month, CCTV staff and volunteers got out into the community and made the trek over to Bush Park to record the headlining band at this year's Salem Art Fair.

AUGUST 2017

In August, CCTV had the opportunity to livestream Salem's solar eclipse. With the help of local astronomers and city officials, CCTV provided live coverage of the eclipse and updates on traffic conditions, all from the roof of our building. We also worked in conjunction with KMUZ to simulcast the program on community radio.

SEPTEMBER 2017

School sports started up in early September, and CCTV crews stayed busy recording some phenomenal high school football and volleyball games. Our annual Volunteer/Producer party was also held this month!

OCTOBER 2017

In October, CCTV began offering a brand new Audio Basics class, giving new and experienced community producers the opportunity to run sound both in a studio setting and in the field. This month, CCTV also recorded the controversial OSAA redistricting hearings, providing our community access to changes happening in local schools.

NOVEMBER 2017

True to CCTV tradition, November bustled with activity during our Non-Profit Holiday Greetings. Over the course of two weeks, CCTV hosted 54 non-profit organizations, all of whom created a festive holiday message to play on CCTV's channels during the holiday season.

DECEMBER 2017

Ashley Gruber joined CCTV staff in December, allowing us to provide full time editing and video instruction and assistance to the Salem community. CCTV also jumped into the arts community this month, hosting an art exhibit as part of local non-profit Artists In Action's annual Something Red event.

JANUARY 2018

CCTV partnered with Salem Concert Band in January to record "The Garden of Earthly Delights" with music by composer Leroy Osmon and performances by Rainbow Dance Theatre and Salem Concert Band. We rounded out the month by recording two local marches at the Capitol: MLK Jr March and Womxn's March.

FEBRUARY 2018

February saw the start of another popular local arts & culture program at CCTV; we began recording open mic sessions once monthly at Taproot Lounge & Cafe downtown.

MARCH 2018

March began with staff and volunteers at the Chiles Center in Portland recording OSAA High School Basketball State Championships. Congratulations to Sprague High School's Boys team for making it to the semifinals!

APRIL 2018

Spring music kicked off in April, with CCTV recording ten music productions this month alone! At the end of the month, CCTV closed its studios for two days to attend the Best of the Northwest Film Festival awards reception in Portland, and came home with an award for sports programs, and another for overall excellence!

MAY 2018

In May, CCTV staff and volunteers gathered twice at Bush Park, once to record Salem-Keizer Education Foundation's Awesome 3000 event, and again the next week for Country Kids Relays.

JUNE 2018

June was a busy month for CCTV! We worked closely with city and county officials to provide essential information on city water contamination in four languages, we recorded 13 local graduations, and hosted 13 bands at a CCTV stage for Make Music Day. What a great way to start the summer!



CCTV MUSIC: *Local Roots*

In its fourth year, CCTV's partnership with Local Roots Music NW has continued to grow. Over the last year, we co-produced 20 Local Roots programs, featuring bands from all over the Willamette Valley. This season saw a variety of music genres including rock, folk, electronic, blues, americana, punk, and more.

The goal of the Local Roots music series is to support and celebrate the local arts community, and offer bands the opportunity to record valuable promotional material. The program allows local musicians to interact with fans who otherwise might not be able to see their live performances. Local Roots has also served as a training environment for volunteers of all ages and abilities, quickly becoming a popular and highly sought-after volunteer opportunity.

With nearly 100 Local Roots performances recorded to date, we look forward to another great year of music production at CCTV!

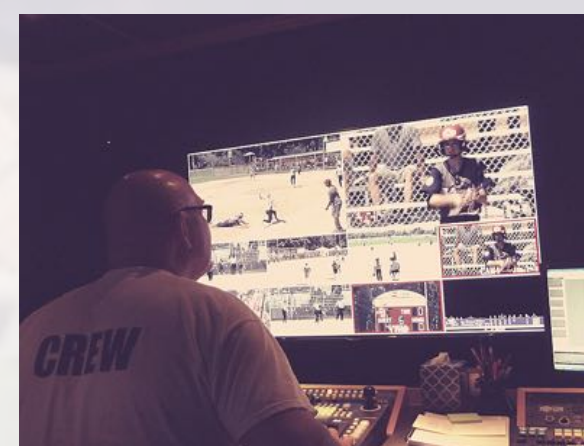

ASA/USA GIRLS 18A NATIONAL SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

This August, CCTV staff and volunteers braved the summer heat to record 10 fast pitch softball games at Wallace Marine Park Athletic Complex. The ASA/USA Girls 18A Fast Pitch Nationals brought 50 teams from around the country to Salem's fields, and CCTV was honored to be a part of the event!

CCTV crews spent 3 full days at the parks working from our 37 foot production truck, and produced just over 17 hours of sports programming on the channel.





Salem Connection

IN PARTNERSHIP WITH CITY OF SALEM

Salem Connection is a monthly program series created by City of Salem staff and produced by CCTV staff Soha Badiei. The purpose of the ten minute program is to keep our community up to date on local issues and upcoming events in Salem. During its four years of production, this program has provided in-depth coverage on topics ranging from neighborhood associations to clean drinking water to upcoming urban development projects. 2018 SOLAR ECLIPSE

On Monday August 21, 2017, CCTV televised and streamed the total solar eclipse live from our facility. The program stemmed from CCTV's role as a Joint Information Center (JIC) for the City of Salem and Marion County. We went live from 9:00am to noon, with volunteers Brad Wartman and Tim Lockrem offering expert commentary from the roof throughout the morning.

The setup was complex, and included three cameras on the roof of the building, two cameras in studio one, a live information crawl, the ODOT 18 traffic camera feed, and a PSU weather balloon. Our live coverage of the eclipse reached at least nine states and three countries, including Spain and Italy. The live stream was viewed more than 47,000 times on YouTube, and over 11,000 times on Facebook. Many community media centers across the country shared our live stream on their channels and social media sites.

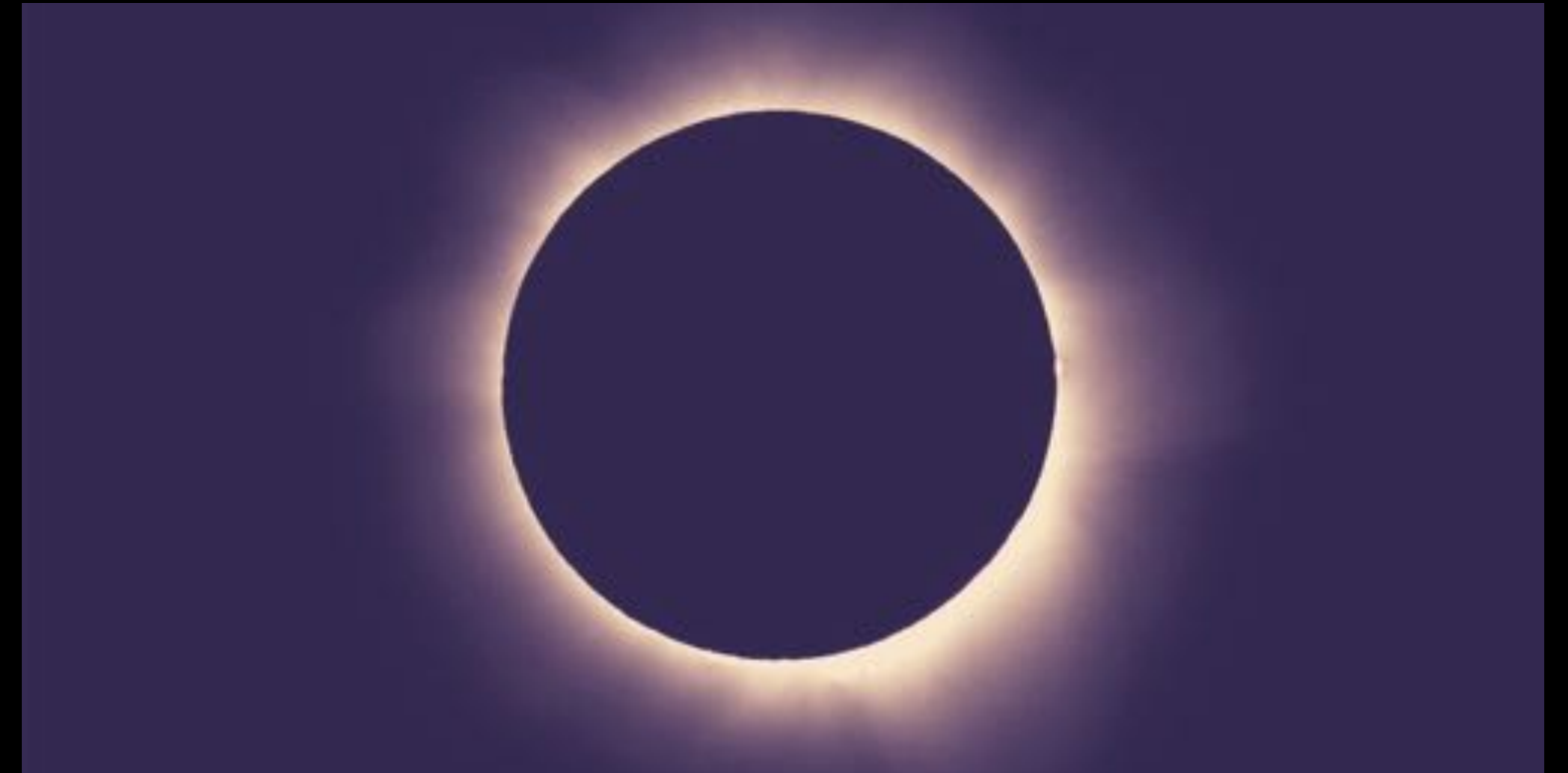

This introductory course teaches students how to operate CCTV's high-definition camcorders that are available for checkout. The class covers basic shooting practices and using a tripod.

EDITING

A two-hour course for beginning editors in Final Cut Pro X editing software. The class walks students through many of the basic software features, giving editors the tools they need to finish their first program.

STUDIO

Students learn how to make a program in CCTV's studios from start to finish. Training includes operation of studio cameras, audio mixing, directing, creating graphics, lighting a set and more.

MEDIA LITERACY VISITS & WORKSHOPS

CCTV offers tours and workshops for groups who wish to learn more about the world of community media. During the 17-18 fiscal year, CCTV provided tours, studio experience, and beginner editing training to twelve groups, including homeschool groups, Girl Scout troops, Chemeketa Community College students, local childcare programs and more.





SUMMER VIDEO CAMP 2017

This July, CCTV was taken over for three weeks by staff member Phillip DeRobertis and fourteen enthusiastic filmmakers, aged 9 to 14 years old, for our annual Summer Video Camp (SVC). Each week of SVC had a different theme: week one taught the basics of camera function and shot composition, week two was a study in stop-motion animation, and week three was a culmination of skills learned, concluding with a film festival and ice cream sundaes at the end of the month.

The young producers are encouraged to work together to create a handful of short films that reflect their personalities and what they are interested in. Among highlights from this year was *A Love Story*, the story of two microphones falling in love at Starbucks.

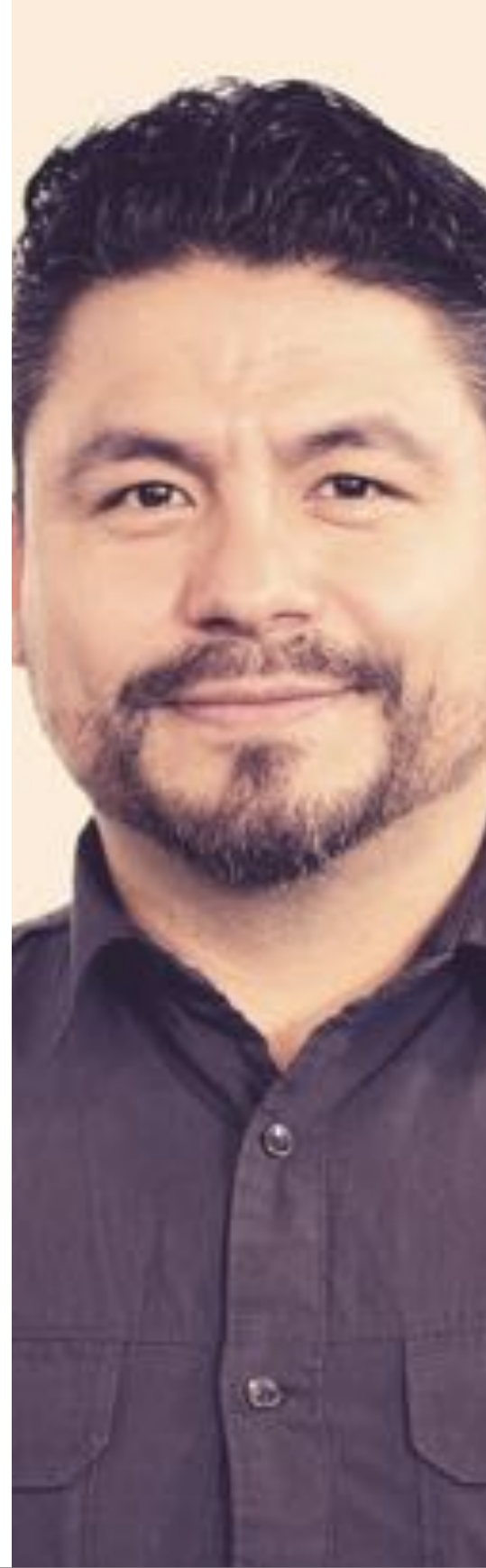
